



Product Safety Statement Concerning Primeline Industries' Natural Rubber Latex Tubing and California Proposition 65 Chemicals

California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 also known as Proposition 65 states:

“No person in the course of doing business shall knowingly discharge or release a chemical know to the state to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity into water or onto or into land where such chemical passes or probably will pass into any source of drinking water, notwithstanding any other provision or authorization of law except as provided in Section 25249.9.”

and:

“No person in the course of doing business shall knowingly and intentionally expose any individual to a chemical know to the states to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity without first giving clear and reasonable warning to such individual, except as provided in Section 25249.10”

Based on the Proposition 65 list of chemical known to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity dated March 19, 2021 and Proposition 65 Safe Harbor Levels dated March 25, 2021, Primeline Industries is not required to label our latex tubing with safety warnings as is required by California Proposition 65.
